
Itinerary #1 Sarlat and Eyrignac

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Itinerary #01

Main Sites

Sarlat la Caneda



2.5-3 hour visit including lunch

The town of Sarlat is world renowned as one of the best preserved medieval towns – it was one of the largest medieval urban areas in the world from the 13th to 16th centuries. It is a warren of alleyways, virtually unchanged since the middle ages, lined with warm ochre stone houses, small galleries including the famous "Herdin", art shops and lots of shops selling local produce.

The Saturday market offers a lively, bustling experience where you can find foie gras, the famous cepe mushrooms, magret (duck breasts) & confit (conserves of duck or goose), truffles, walnuts, strawberries and other delicious local products to tempt your taste buds.

Jardins de Manoir Eyrignac



1-2 hour visit depending on walks

Set high in the Périgord Noir, the gardens provide 10 hectares of sculpted plants to discover. A unique example of Topiary Art in France, offers yews, box trees, hornbeams and cypresses as the main species.

The volume and the variety of green sculptures are what make Eyrignac so special: sculpted plants, greenery rooms, boxwood embroideries, French-style garden bed. There are 7 gardens to explore as well as a 2.5 and 4.5 km nature walk on the 200-hectare forestry estate.

A visitor guide from the entrance, iPod touch guide (to rent), or a phone App will take you on your own selfguided tour.

Montignac



1 hour visit + dining

Main centre for visiting prehistoric sites in the Vézère valley. The old town North of the river has a maze of streets with fourteenth- to sixteenth-century timbered houses. Pick up a map from the tourist office showing a route around the town including all main highlights.

There are events throughout the year, but the main reason for being on this itinerary is as somewhere to stop for dinner on your return to Bonnes Routes. You will drive through Montignac on return from Eyrignac – so it's a great place to stop for a wander along the river.

There are a number of restaurants overlooking the river offering outside dining on a warm evening including:

- Les Pilotis (traditional, meats, salads, pizza)
- Le Triskell (creperie)
- Aux Berges la Vezere (traditional and pizza)
- La Chaumiere (Southern France/Perigordian)

Many restaurants don't open until 7 pm particularly off season

Follow Trip #C16 to Sarlat

←1	From Bonhur, turn left onto N21 to Thiviers roundabout	for 16 km
	Third exit at Thiviers roundabout - D707 Lanouaille	for 21 km
↦	At Lanouaille turn right on D704 signed A89	for 31 km
	Third exit for D6089 to Terrasson, and first exit at the next roundabout, continuing to follow the D6089	for 5.5 km
┍→	At the major crossroads/traffic lights in Le Lardin turn right onto the D704 to Sarlat / Montignac	for 9.5 km
	Second exit to Montignac, then second exit at the next roundabout onto the D704E to Sarlat	for 2.5 km
←	Turn left at the junction back onto the D704 for Sarlat	for 24 km
	First exit to Cahors/Bergerac staying on the D704	for 500 m
┍→	Arrive at Sarlat parking just past the cemetery	

To Manoir de L'Eyrignac

←	Drive North on D704 to roundabout	for 500 m
	Second exit to Proissans then <table-cell-rows> 🏲 🕇 signed Proissans</table-cell-rows>	for 2 km
←	On D47 to Saint Nathalene	for 6 km
←	After Saint Nathalene turn left signed La Palombiere	for 2.5 km
⚠	At a tiny crossroads go straight (cream house to the right) then follow signs to Jardins Eyrignac	for 2 km
←	Arrive at Jardins Eyrignac	

Follow Trip #J2 Jardins de L'Eyrignac (return portion) to Montignac

4	Turn left out of the gardens	for 3.5 km			
4	At the D61 junction follow signs left to Salignac	for 2.5 km			
4	At the main Salignac junction follow sign to Sarlat	for 2.5 km			
↦	Turn right onto D61 to Montignac	for 5.5 km			
↦	After Saint Genies turn onto D704	for 11 km			
←	Arrive at Montignac – go straight at the first roundabout to the parking 130 m on the right				
Continue to follow Trip #J2 (return portion) to Bonnes Routes					
٢	Turn left out of the parking then at the roundabouts follow signs to A89 - follow the D704 to Le Lardin Saint Vézère	for 11 km			
←	At the crossroads/traffic lights in Le Lardin turn onto the D6089 , signed A89 / Château de Hautefort	for 5 km			
	Take exits to Saint Yrieix / Limoges at both roundabouts then drive North on the D704 to Lanouaille	for 30 km			
4	At the brick junction in Lanouaille turn onto D707 (Thiviers)	for 21 km			
	At the Thiviers roundabout take the second exit to N21 to La Coquille	for 16 km			
↦	After La Coquille turn right into Bonhur	for 500 m			
	Arrive at Bonnes Routes
